解釋 (Interpretation):

第一段：1-3 節

1. 請形容在經文中的這個乞丐。他每天過的是如何的生活？

2. 為甚麼他會在聖殿的美門求乞呢？

3. 有一天這個生來瘸腿的乞丐看到彼得和約翰時，他向他們提出了甚麼的要求？這個要求合理嗎？

第二段：4-8 節

4. 你認為彼得和約翰為何會定睛看着這個乞丐呢？

5. 彼得有沒有答允乞丐的要求呢？他所給予乞丐的和乞丐所求的有甚麼分別？

6. 經文記載彼得「拉著他的右手、扶他起來」(v7) 代表了甚麼事情？彼得憑着甚麼有那樣的信心呢？

第三段：9 – 10 節

7. 在殿內的百姓看到這個乞丐能行走時，他們有甚麼反應？為甚麼？

8. 在這段的經文中，有誰的生命被扭轉？請解釋。

附錄：經文（使徒行傳 3：1－10）

(1) 和合本：

- 3:1 申初禱告的時候、彼得、約翰、上聖殿去。
3:2 有一個人、生來是癱腿的、天天被人抬來、放在殿的一個門口、那門名叫美門、要求進殿的人賙濟。
3:3 他看見彼得約翰將要進殿、就求他們賙濟。
3:4 彼得約翰定睛看他、彼得說、你看我們。
3:5 那人就留意看他們、指望得著甚麼。
3:6 彼得說、金銀我都沒有、只把我所有的給你、我奉拿撒勒人耶穌基督的名、叫你起來行走。
3:7 於是拉著他的右手、扶他起來、他的腳和踝子骨、立刻健壯了。
3:8 就跳起來、站著、又行走、同他們進了殿、走著、跳著、讚美神。
3:9 百姓都看見他行走、讚美神。
3:10 認得他是那素常坐在殿的美門口求賙濟的、就因他所遇著的事、滿心希奇驚訝。

(2) NIV:

3 One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the time of prayer—at three in the afternoon. ² Now a man who was lame from birth was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put every day to beg from those going into the temple courts. ³ When he saw Peter and John about to enter, he asked them for money. ⁴ Peter looked straight at him, as did John. Then Peter said, “Look at us!” ⁵ So the man gave them his attention, expecting to get something from them.

⁶ Then Peter said, “Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.” ⁷ Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man’s feet and ankles became strong. ⁸ He jumped to his feet and began to walk. Then he went with them into the temple courts, walking and jumping, and praising God. ⁹ When all the people saw him walking and praising God, ¹⁰ they recognized him as the same man who used to sit begging at the temple gate called Beautiful, and they were filled with wonder and amazement at what had happened to him.
